

The Luksic Fellows Program for Babson SEE Graduates

April 5 - 10, 2020

Babson College, Wellesley, Massachusetts USA

The Luksic Fellows Program is a professional development immersion experience.

The Babson Luksic Fellows Program is a 5-day residential program for SEE-Chile alums to experience an extended learning journey to Babson College located just outside of Boston, Massachusetts, USA. The program seeks to attract innovative faculty who have a long-term commitment to entrepreneurship education at both the professional and institutional level.

The five-day program will be split between in-class seminars and practical excursions to experience entrepreneurship education in the ecosystems of Babson and Boston. This type of program set-up aligns with Babson's experiential learning approach, but will also allow Chilean faculty to feel what it is like to be a part of a robust entrepreneurial learning community. In-class content will build on what was learned during the SEE-Chile program while outside-of-class content connects the Fellows to best practice examples related to teaching, developing curriculum, and building co-curricular activities.

During the program each Fellow will be assigned a Babson faculty mentor for one-on-one coaching for 1.5 hours. Babson mentors help Fellows on specific challenges related to building and growing entrepreneurship programs. Such challenges could be related to curriculum design, co-curricular activities, leadership and administration, and research. Additionally, each Fellow will receive an additional four hours of virtual mentoring post program within 6 months. Fellows and Babson mentors work together to design an action plan to meet professional and institutional goals.

Babson College will select up to ten Fellows.

Only graduates from the Chilean SEE program sponsored by the Luksic family are eligible to apply for the Luksic Fellows Program. Graduates of the Chilean SEE Program are only eligible to apply during the year they attend the SEE Program. Through a strategic and institutional partnership, Babson College will fully fund the program for up to ten (10) Fellows, including the costs of tuition to the Program, associated fees and on campus lodging for each Fellow. Fellows are responsible for all airfare and all transportation needs while at Babson.

Applications are due no later than October 1, 2019 and Fellows will be notified of acceptance by November 1, 2019.

The application process requires interested SEE-Chile graduates to submit: (1) a letter of intent and (2) a letter from the Dean or other supervisor confirming support for the faculty member's participation in the Luksic Fellows program.

The letter of intent must address the following:

- What are your professional goals and how can a 5-day immersion experience at Babson help you achieve these goals?
- What do you want to accomplish for yourself while at Babson?
- What role do you have at your institution and how can your participation in the program help your institution develop in the area of entrepreneurship education?
- Discuss your level of English proficiency (oral and written). English proficiency is mandatory.
