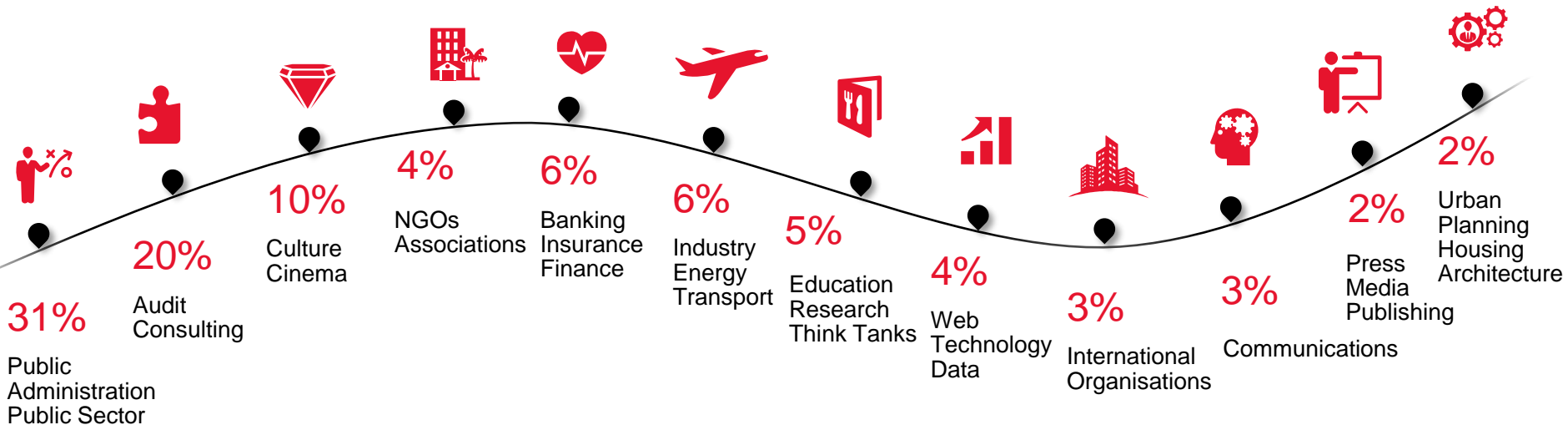

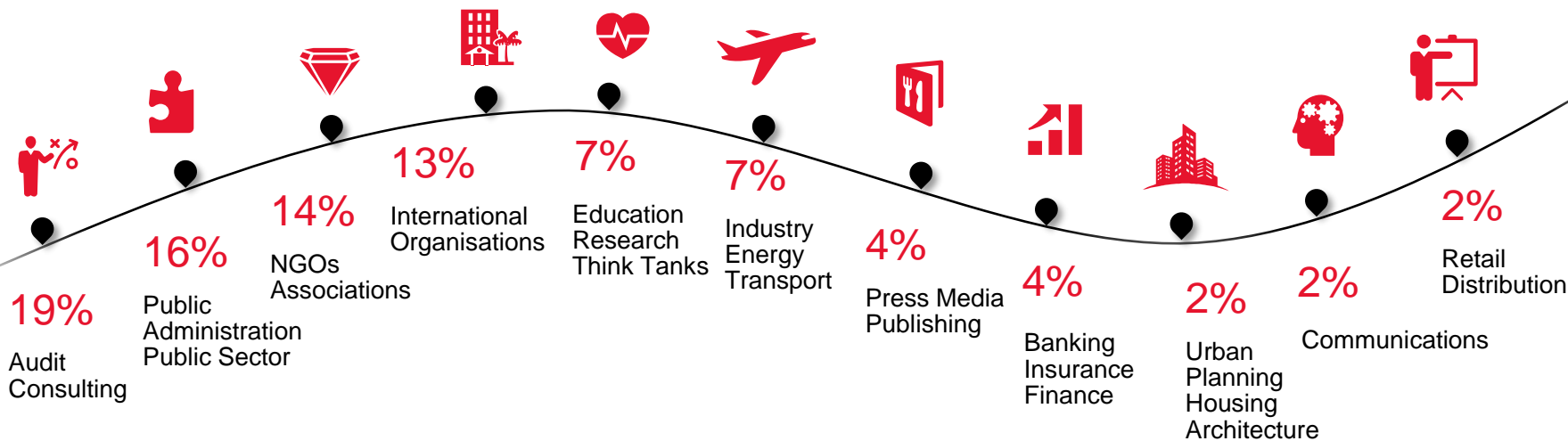

## The Luksic Scholarship for Public Service at Sciences Po

Scholarship recipients must be Chilean nationals who are ordinarily resident in Chile (without dual citizenship from any European Union country). For the avoidance of doubt, Chilean nationals currently living outside Chile solely for the purpose of study shall be deemed to be ordinarily resident in Chile.

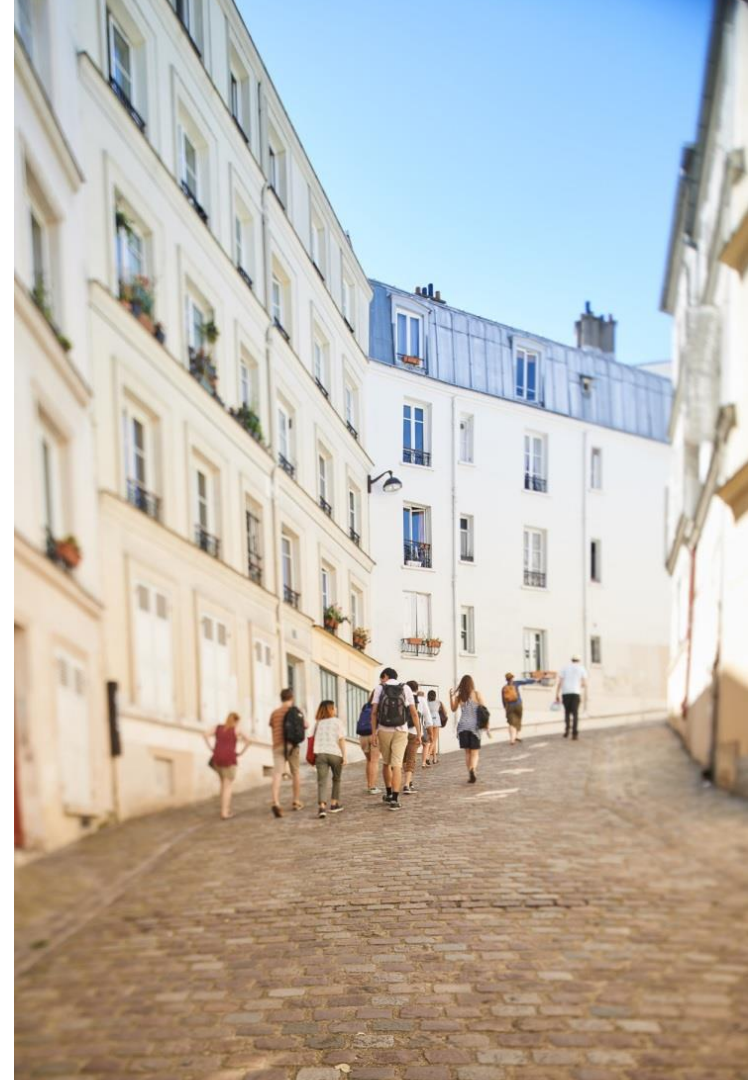
